

Terms and Conditions for Boston Manor Park

Please find below the terms and conditions for Boston Manor Park, your deposit (£1,000 per day) will not be refunded if these are not adhered to.

Access and egress must be maintained at all times.

Vehicles or heavy equipment is not permitted on the bridge.

You are not permitted to attach anything to the flyover structure/gantry without written permission from Highways England.

The location must be left as found. All refuse must be taken away and recycled where possible, any refuse being collected after you leave the site must not be left unattended.

All refuse must be stored in lidded containers throughout the duration of the base.

All equipment must be manned at all times.

A resident letter must be delivered into the doors of homes and business directly affected by the parking bay suspensions on Boston Manor Road with the reason of suspension, duration, acknowledgement of inconvenience and contact phone number.

Coning of the suspended bays is not permitted.

All vehicle movement must be strictly supervised with two banks men (increasing to three when necessary i.e. bad weather, other local situations (road works, road closures) that may increase the complexity of the entry and exit manoeuvres), hazard lights must be displayed at all times and you must not exceed 5mph.

No Large vehicle/ trailer movements permitted into the car park gate during the time of the bus lane operation i.e. 07.00 - 10.00hrs on weekdays

Vehicles must be parked along the sides of the hardstanding area, an access path must be maintained throughout the middle for 16T Trucks to have access.

Catering vehicles or any vehicles holding gas canisters must not be parked under the flyover, they must park on the grass verge.

The entrance to the base must be manned at all times to prevent other vehicles gaining access.

Noise must be kept to a minimum.

The barrier must be locked and the key returned within 24 hours of leaving the base.
