ⁱⁱ Material changes are considered large element changes. This does not include date changes. Date changes can be made within 24 hours for lane/sidewalk and five (5) business days for full street closure.

ⁱⁱⁱ ITC, Intermittent Traffic Control, must be managed by sworn DeKalb Police Officers.

^{iv} A DeKalb Police Officer is required on-site for any filming that necessitates a lane or road closure or ITC.

^v Fire and/or EMS personnel will be required when filming involves blasting, use of flammable materials, or other activities that may cause harm to participants or the public or as determined by Fire Marshal.
