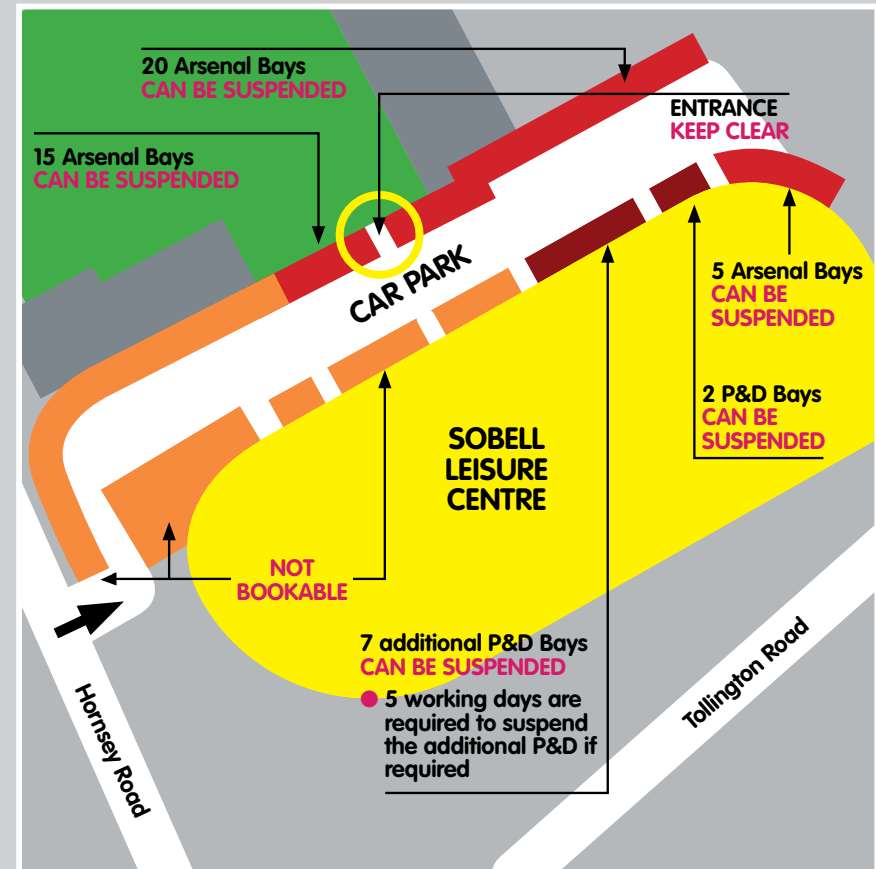


Terms & conditions for unit base parking for film crews at Sobell Leisure Centre

Residents have objected to the noise made by crews working during unsociable hours (2200 – 0700) at the Sobell Leisure Centre. Crews that do not respect the needs of residents jeopardise the Council's ability to offer Unit Bases to productions. Adhering to these terms is considered to be the responsibility of Production and the Location Department. We have therefore implemented the following measures:

- No movement of large vehicles between 22.00 – 07.00. This includes rubbish collections.
- All unit moves taking place in the evening will need to be fully completed by 22.00. Any unforeseen circumstances that cause a delay, or insufficient Facilities Drivers to complete the unit move by 22.00, will mean the move must be completed after 0700 the following day regardless of the impact on call time.
- Generators must be switched off overnight.
- All site bookings require a Deposit of £500 – this will not be refunded if there is vehicle activity between the hours of 22.00 – 07.00
- Crew to be quiet and respectful at all times. No loud talking, shouting, phone calls or smoking on the street.
- All Security personnel (day & night) must be fully briefed as to how to avoid disturbing the residents at this Unit Base. They must be given the authority to send away late arrivals
- Caterers should ideally park up the night before and away from the houses. They must be clearly instructed by Locations about the noise curfew. We understand their work can start at 05.00 but this must be carried out as quietly as possible.
