Filming, Street, Lane, and Sidewalk Restrictions

19 July 2017

- Red = No Closures of Sidewalk, Parking Lane, or Travel Lane; No Filming.** [Poplar from Cone to Forsyth; Fairlie from Walton to Luckie]
- Blue = No Closures of Sidewalk, Parking/Planter Lane, or Travel Lane Closest to the Tuttle Building.** [Forsyth Street from Walton to Poplar]
- Yellow = Sidewalk, Parking Lane, and Travel Lane Closures Permitted right of the Center Yellow Line in Street.** [Opposite Courthouse: Forsyth Street from Walton to Poplar]
- Green = No Closures of Sidewalk, Parking Lane, or Travel Lane Closest to the Godbold Building.** [Cone from Walton to Poplar]
- Purple = No Closures of Parking Lanes, Sidewalks, or Travel Lanes except on Weekends and from 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM on Week Days.** [Walton Street from Cone to Forsyth] During permitted weekend and night closures, the Travel Lane and Parking/Planter Lane on the left closest to the Godbold Building on Walton Street from Cone Street to the Guard Shack will still remain Open for use of the Court Judges and Staff at all Times, and alternative parking will be provided for U.S. Marshals' vehicles on Forsyth Street.
- Orange = Full Street Closure Permitted.** [Fairlie Street from Marietta to Walton]
